*\*\*There will be a modified version in the Run-Around-Room for Toddlers-PreK.*



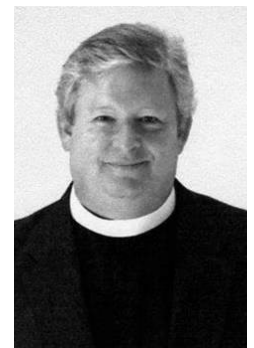
**The Rev. Tommie Watkins**
